<u>Community Band:</u> After seeing our Christmas concert, a senior flute student at BFA asked if he could join Stadtmusik Kandern. It is a good opportunity for him to play in the group, and I get to translate for him! I have also spent some time hanging out with a couple members of band, building those relationships.
